Regulations

This prize was introduced a few years ago. Paul Ward was Deputy Director of the Operating Department Practice until his tragic death, at age 39, in 2008. Paul had been the driving force in introducing the BSc programme, the SCP programme and The MSc -Managing Care in Perioperative Practice Programme and we felt it appropriate, in his name, to recognise a student who has excelled in one of the post registration programmes for which he worked so hard to implement. Since its creation the prize has been sponsored annually by Intersurgical Ltd.

The winner of the prize is selected by closed vote, from a list of students nominated by members of the perioperative team. Academic achievement is considered alongside improvements during the period of study and overall contribution to the programme.

The Prize will normally be known as the 'Paul Ward Memorial Prize for Post Registration Studies'.

The Prize will be normally be awarded annually to a student graduating from any of the Perioperative Practice Post Registration Programmes.
